St. Luke Lutheran Community Volunteer Positions

We ask that all of our volunteers have a sincere desire to help, strong interpersonal communication skills and a friendly, caring, patient personality. We also ask that they maintain strict confidentiality for our residents per the policies of St. Luke Lutheran Community.

You are able to volunteer for as few or as many hours per month as you would like. Activities typically last about 2 - 3 hours.

We do require volunteers serving more than 10 hours per year complete a 2 step TB test, which we provide here free of charge. You would get a small injection and return 2 days later to have it checked, then repeat the process the next week.

Activities volunteers:

Assist residents to and from activities, such as: Bingo, games, crafts and musical performances. This does require the ability to push wheelchairs.

Assist residents with impaired eyesight or hearing difficulty during activity as requested.

Assist the group leader before, during and after the activity with setup, distributing materials and prizes, and clean up.

Assist in decorating Nursing facility in decorating for Holidays and special events throughout the year. This includes Nurses stations, walls, resident doors, lounge areas, and all other areas with decorations.

Notify supervisor of any needed items, problems, concerns, or progress you have noted.

Religious volunteers:

Assist residents to and from Religious services and Bible studies. This does require the ability to push wheelchairs.

Assist residents with impaired eyesight or hearing difficulty as requested.

Assist the group leader before, during and after the activity with setup, distributing materials, and clean up.

Assist with planning for Bible study and devotions, and preparing needed materials.

If musically talented, perform during services.

Visit with residents requesting religious visitors throughout the home in their rooms or in our lounges to provide religious companionship and interaction. You may talk and share time with resident or read to resident if requested to do so.

Notify supervisor of any needed items, problems, concerns, or progress you have noted.

Friendly Visitors:

Provide companionship and interaction for residents who are in need of company in their rooms or in designated areas.

Talk and share time with resident and read to them if requested.

Notify supervisor of any needed items, problems, concerns, or progress you have noted

Manicure Volunteers:

Perform manicures for residents whom desire them.

Allow the resident to choose the color, soak finger tips in warm sudsy water (if desired) and file nails to desired length. We ask the volunteers do not trim fingernails and leave a small gap between nail bed and cuticle when painting their nails.

Notify supervisor of any needed items, problems, concerns, or progress you have noted

Outings Volunteers:

Assist in transporting residents to and from community outings (Shopping, Lunch, Bowling, etc.) on St. Luke's Bus and to assist residents as needed while out. This includes getting them from their room out to the bus and back to their room following outing and assisting residents from bus to outing.

Assist residents with impaired eyesight or hearing difficulty during outing as requested.

Assist the group leader before, during and after the outing.

Notify supervisor of any needed items, problems, concerns, or progress you have noted

Music Volunteers:

Perform music for residents during special events or meal times.

Notify supervisor of any needed items, problems, concerns, or progress you have noted

Laundry Volunteers:

Assist staff in daily activities of Laundry Department and any additional assignments as assigned by Laundry supervisor. This requires the ability to lift laundry bundles. Knowledge of laundry equipment is preferred.

Use equipment such as washers, dryers, and irons. (As approved by director)

Hanging, folding and sorting resident clothing.

Notify supervisor of any needed items, problems, concerns, or progress you have noted.

Housekeeping Volunteers:

Assist staff in daily activities of Housekeeping Department and any additional assignments as assigned by Housekeeping supervisor. This requires the ability to lift equipment and trash bags. Knowledge of cleaning equipment is preferred.

Notify supervisor of any needed items, problems, concerns, or progress you have noted.

Dietary Volunteers:

Assist staff in daily activities of Dietary Department and any additional assignments as assigned by Dietary supervisor. Duties may include: serving meals to residents, assisting residents in our dining halls, cleaning dining halls and washing dishes.

Notify supervisor of any needed items, problems, concerns, or progress you have noted.
