## What is Paper Retriever?

Paper Retriever is a simple recycling program that directly benefits St. Luke Lutheran Community as well as the environment. Nonprofit organizations across the country place the distinctive green-and-yellow bins in highly visible areas where members of the community and the organization itself can donate their recyclable paper. St. Luke is then paid based on the tonnage that our bin collects; those funds can be used for programs to benefit staff and residents of St. Luke.

Paper Retriever is a true Full-Circle Recycler.® AbitibiBowater uses the paper it collects for use in making newspapers. The paper you recycle today may be the newspaper you read in just a few weeks... again in two months...and again.
