St. Luke's scheduled date for absentee voting on site is Tuesday, October 27th. The board of elections is not able to assist inside the building that day due to the visitor restrictions in place. The board of elections has trained or deputized 2 resident life staff members (one democrat, one republican) to assist residents that may have a need. The rules on providing "assistance" are very strict and will be adhered to by both those individuals deputized. The resident life director will supervise the entire process/procedure and the board of elections staff will be on site until voting is complete. Ballot applications were submitted only for those residents that were registered, requesting to vote and able to identify their name/birthdate/#ss. Residents are screened at the facility according to the Board of Elections recommendations prior to every election. There is a small group of residents that will absentee vote by mail because they are able to do so independently. All others will absentee vote on the 27th. If voting is not completed on the 27th the board will return to finish the process later that same week.
