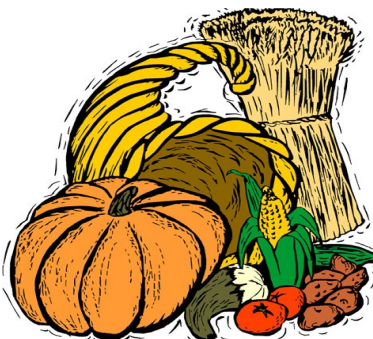
St. Luke Lutheran Community
